June is Speak about Aphasia month

Did you know only 3% of people have heard about aphasia yet more than 350,000 people in the UK have it. Aphasia is a communication disability caused by the language centres of the brain. It can affect speech, reading, writing and sometimes understanding. It does not affect intelligence. This can be caused by stroke, head injury or other neurological conditions.

A UK communication access symbol has been designed with help from a local aphasia charity, Speakeasy. Businesses can display this if their staff have had training in how to help people communicate.
